In the first half term, year 4 will be learning about place value to 4 digits. We will be ordering and comparing numbers which will help us add and subtract numbers later this term.

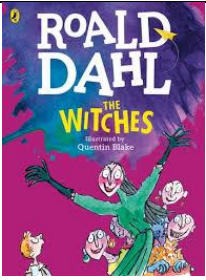
Our second unit will be addition and subtraction. We will be learning to use written strategies to add and subtract.



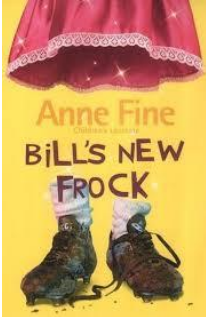
## English
