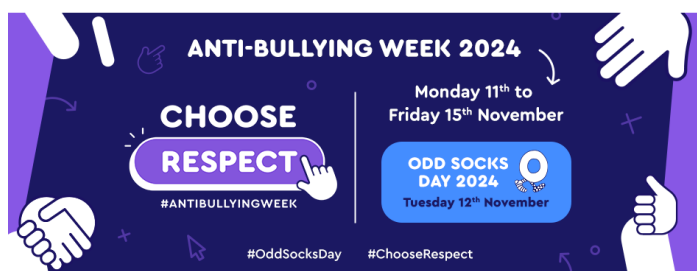
National Anti-bullying week - Week Beginning 11th November
