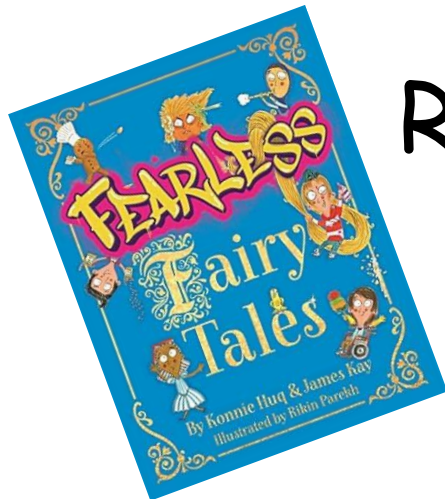


Boris and Sid make a mess
