Children will be escorted to their 'circles' at 8.50 by a member of staff.

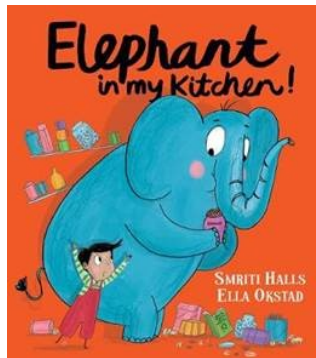
## Lost Property

# Book of the month

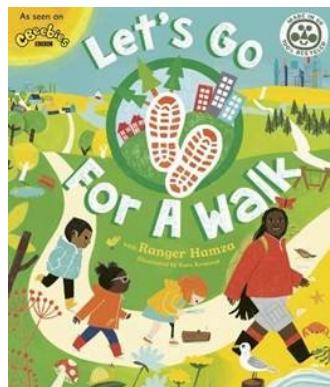

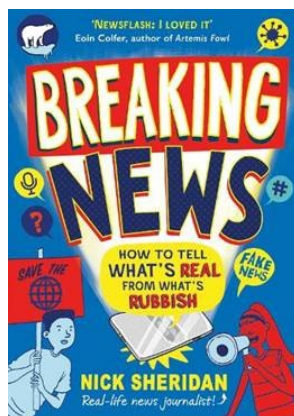

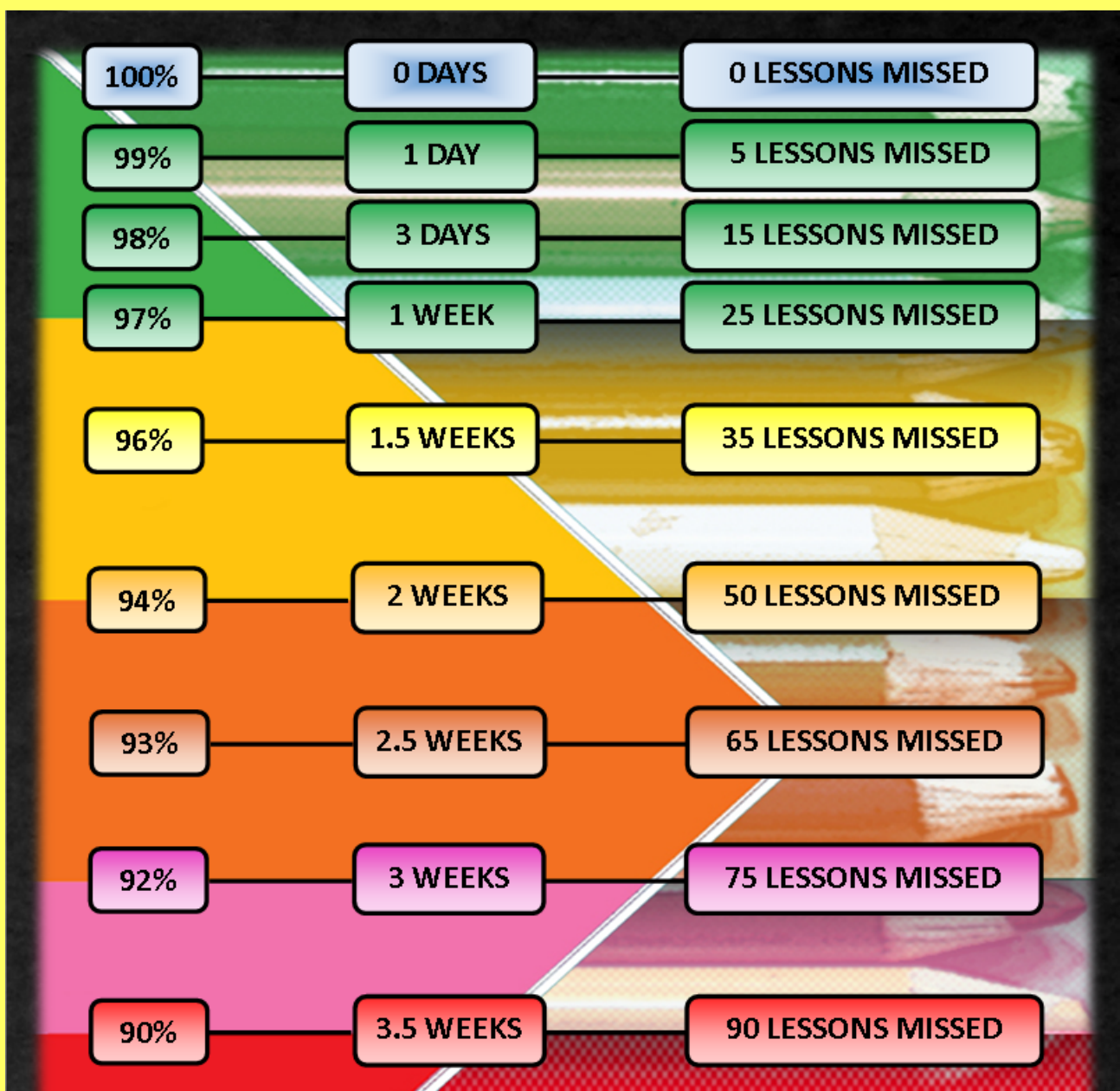
