

SATs organisation 2025

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you may be aware, Year 6 pupils across the country undertake statutory assessments in May, these assessments are commonly known as SATs. This year, **SATs will start on Monday 12th May 2025**. Children are currently working on final tasks and revision activities in order that they are well-prepared and ready.

Please take note of the following practical arrangements:

1. **Mock SATs** will commence on Monday 28th April to Thursday 1st May. The purpose of this mock week is to allow pupils to practise the routines and procedures for the 'real' SATs. It means that changes to their usual day, such as working in different rooms, following a different timetable etc do not come as shock to them and they are completely confident and relaxed when they undertake their actual tests.
2. **SATs dates** are as follows: Monday 12th May to Thursday 15th May. **Attendance during this week is essential.** If for some reason, your child is not able to attend school, please let us know **immediately**.
3. Breakfast, consisting of toast and a drink, will be served each morning before the tests. This will be free of charge. The purpose of the breakfast is to allow a relaxed and enjoyable start to the day where children can chat and enjoy each other's company. It also allows staff to share key messages and positive encouragement to pupils while they are all in one place.

Please ensure that your child is here on time so that they arrive at school calm and prepared for their day.
