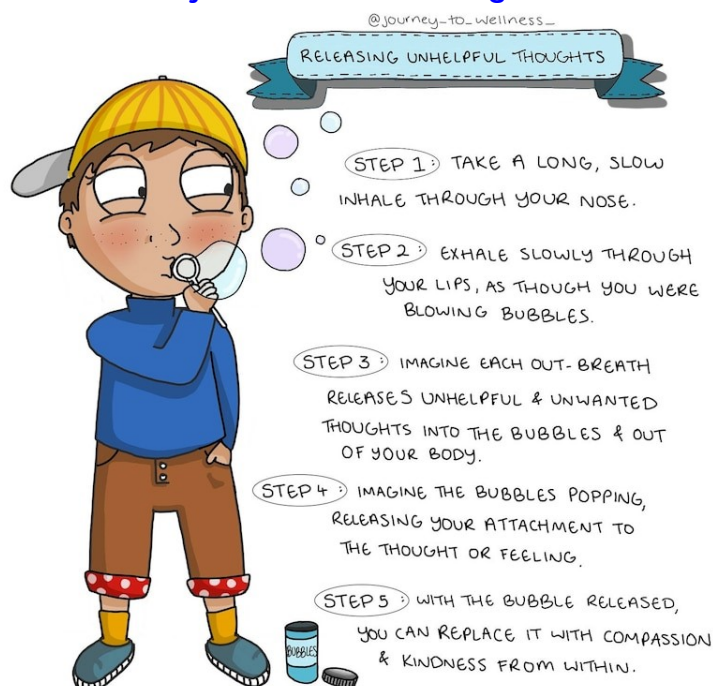


#### REFRAME UNHELPFUL THOUGHTS

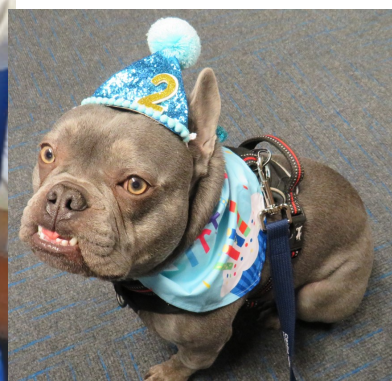
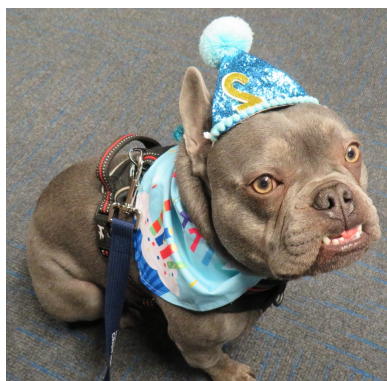

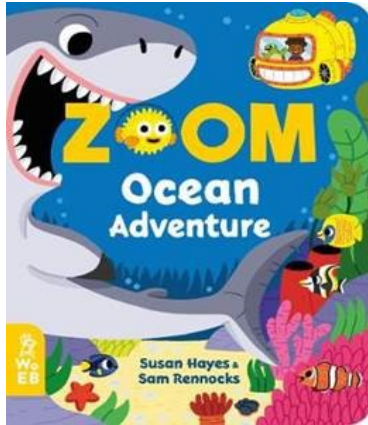

# Book of the month

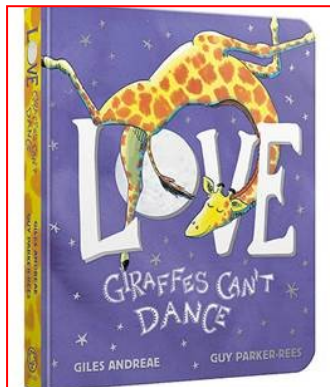
**EYFS**

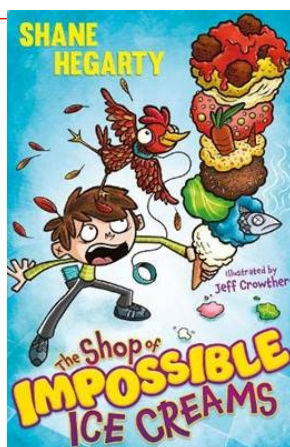
**KS1**

They demonstrated how they had built upon their knowledge from year 2 by sharing that they had been researching a range of facts about the Mayans and then incorporated some of these facts into a song they wrote themselves to help them remember. Finally, they showed their artistic skills with a range of pieces demonstrating their use of sketching, chalk, crayons and printing.

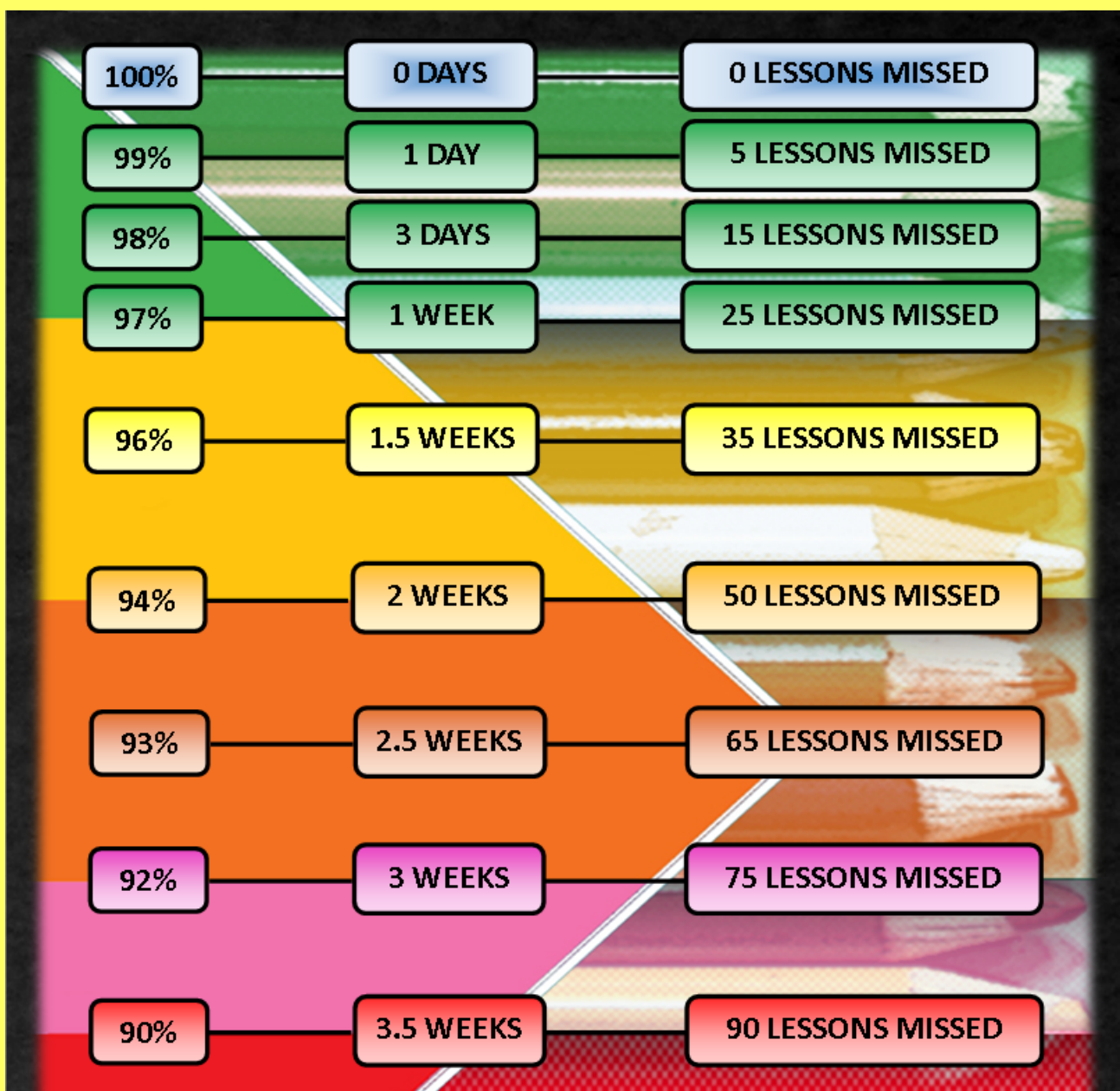

If your child is absent from school for any reason you must notify the school, by phone, email ([fpso@shawprimary.thurrock.sch.uk](mailto:fpso@shawprimary.thurrock.sch.uk)) or in person on the first day of absence.

We have a dedicated absence line which opens from 8am (**01708 852367 -Option 1**) If you call before this time, you can leave a message.

We will not be taking cash/cheques in school except in exceptional circumstances.

**Over previous years our Friends of Shaw have organised events and raised lots of money which helps to buy much needed equipment for our school and saved money on school trips.**

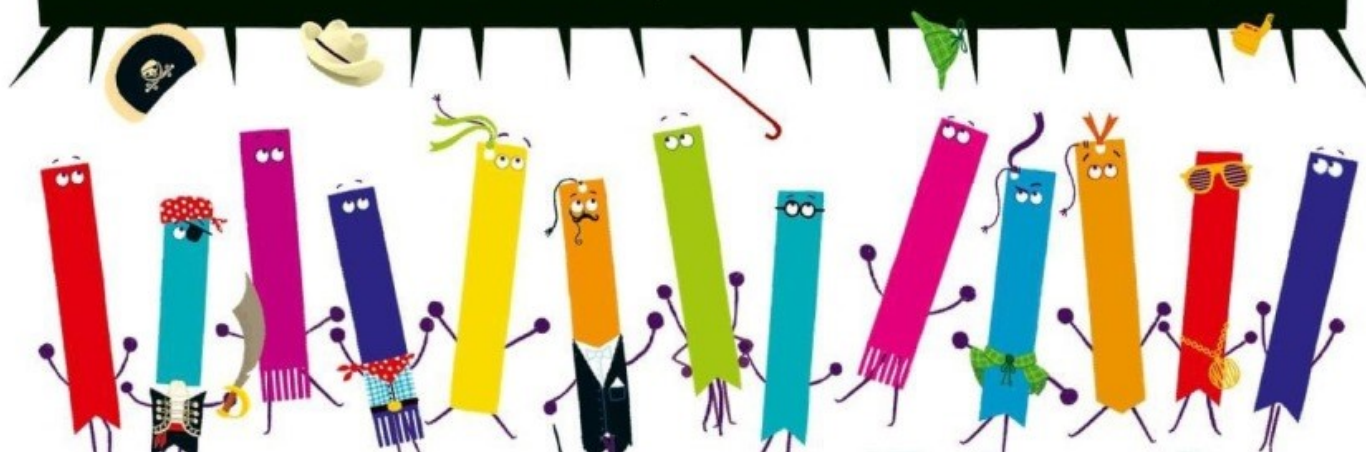
