Maths



Place Value:

We start by focusing on written methods for place value to start with, we then move onto number lines and comparing and ordering numbers. We then finish by looking at rounding numbers.

Addition and Subtraction:

We start by revising mental strategies and add and subtract with more than four digits. Next look at rounding to check answers with inverse operations. Finally calculate multi-step addition and subtraction problems, compare calculations and find missing numbers.

Multiplication and Division:

We start with multiples and factors of numbers, then we focus on prime, cubed and square numbers and finally we finish by looking at written methods for multiplication and division

Fractions:

We start by looking at equivalent fractions, then we move onto converting fractions and mixed numbers and comparing and ordering them. Finally, we compare, add and subtract

English

Gothic Fiction: Goth Girl

Through Chris Riddell's *Goth Girl*, explore how atmosphere, settings & characters are created. Study adverbs of possibility, commas, relative clauses, dialogue punctuation.

Reports and Recounts: Migration

Three amazing texts stimulate children's reading, writing and discussion of first animal, then human, migration. Writing cohesively and using parentheses form the SPaG element, but children's own creative work will make this block truly exciting.

Recounts: UFO' and Aliens

Word classes, noun phrases, fronted adverbials and paragraphs are taught within the context of writing recounts and newspaper reports about UFO accounts.

Anthologies: I Like This Poem

In this unit we read and perform several poems that were personally picked by children. We look at funny poems, long poems, poems that rhyme and don't rhyme, famous poems, old poems, new poems. Any type of poem you can think of we read.
