Family Hubs bring together in one place the health, education and parenting support that families may need for their children aged 0-19, young people up to age 25 with SEND, and for parents/carers.


Our quarterly newsletter will keep you updated with what has been going on in the Family Hubs, meeting the team, upcoming events & hearing from the parent carer panel.

Each child got a free dental pack to take home. We have more Oral Health workshops coming across all localities - contact your local Family Hub for more details.






Coming soon **Promotional Video**

The Parent Carer Panel created a survey to get the voices of dads & non birthing parents, to see how we can best support them going forward as we are aware there is a gap in services. Colin was shocked but delighted to receive the email to congratulate him that he had won a £100 Amazon youcher.

I was shocked to receive the email as you do these surveys but never think you are going to win.

We were looking at buying a baby carrier, so now we can get one. We had our midwife appointments at the Chadwell Family Hub & I saw the survey when I came to get my baby weighed there.

My wife has attended baby massage and some stay & play groups. It was good to be able to have an opinion & a voice as normally all the support is for mum.



Parent Carer Panel





The Parent Carer Panel started back in June 2023 where a group of parents/carers meet up once a month, face to face in each locality & virtually of an evening.

The panel are there to give feedback about the services that are provided focusing on expectant parents until their child reaches the age of 2. The group is made up of diverse parents and carers who want to make a change, shape the services together and are passionate about their voices being heard.

Over the last 8 months they have had guest speakers from Infant Feeding to Parents 1st attend the meetings to give direct feedback and below is everything they have been working on and lots more changes to come.






