



How many snowballs does she use altogether?




Ron has 76 pinecones.

How many pinecones did Mo have at the start?




Rosie saves money in a piggy bank and her bank account.

- She has £27 in her piggy bank.




How much money has she saved altogether?



On a farm, reindeer live in 3 stables.

- There are the same number of reindeer in the 1st stable as the 2<sup>nd</sup> stable.
- There are 12 more reindeer in the 3<sup>rd</sup> stable than in the 1st stable.
- Some of the reindeer are moved from the 3<sup>rd</sup> stable, so that all the stables have the same number of reindeer.
- There are now 36 reindeer in each stable.

How many reindeer were in the 1st stable at the start?



Kim and Dexter each have some decorations.

- If Kim gives Dexter 12 decorations, Dexter will have the same number of decorations as Kim.
- If Dexter gives Kim 12 decorations, Kim will have three times as many decorations as Dexter.
