Science Museum Visit: 12th – 13th July 2024

It is now only a few weeks away from the Science Museum visit, so I am writing to you to inform you of some practical arrangements for the event.

Kit List

Attached to this letter is a Camper Survival Pack with all the information about activities, a kit list as well as meal arrangements. Note that cameras, mobile phones or electronic devices are not allowed. Any devices found in the possession of children will need to be handed in to staff and will be returned to parents at the end of the trip. Should your child wish to spend money at the shop, they are allowed to bring a maximum amount of £10 with them. Children will also need a packed snack for the evening, packed in a separate carrier bag, which can be disposed of afterwards. Please do not pack too many snacks to prevent unnecessary waste and be aware that lunch boxes will only be accessible during designated times.

Please ensure that all bags and clothing are clearly marked with your child's name.

Activities / Group Information

The children will be really busy throughout the evening and we should look forward to some thrilling Science activities. I am sure the children are all happy, if not a little over-excited!

Departure and Arrival Details

Children are asked to have their evening meal before returning to school, and arrive at school at 4.30pm with their packed bag, water bottle and evening snack. All medicines are to be handed to a member of staff.
