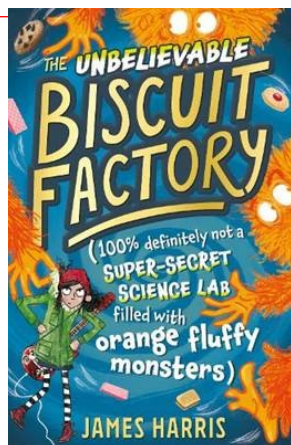

We will not be taking cash/cheques in school except in exceptional circumstances.
